Popular authors, Cookbooks and Children's books, CD's...less than 5 years' old please (We cannot accept text books, dictionaries, encyclopedias or magazines.)

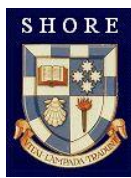

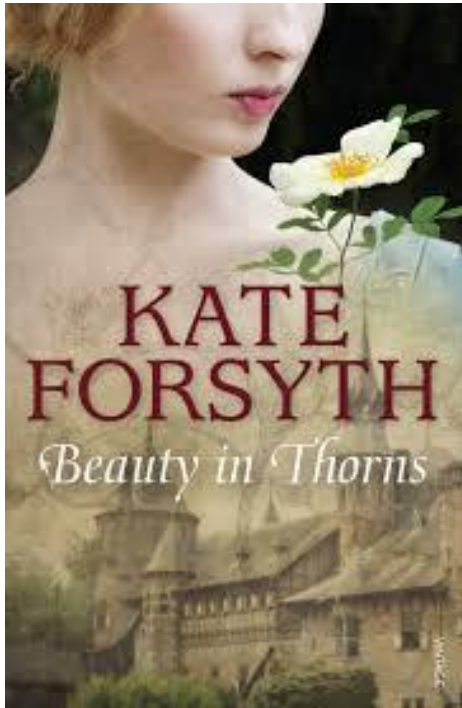
