Scholarship Auditions

Not all applicants will receive an audition. Auditions for students invited to attend will take place at Shore on **Wednesday 3 March 2021**.

The audition will be a maximum of 15 minutes. During this time your son will be required to play TWO contrasting pieces, one displaying his technical ability and the second demonstrating more interpretative skills such as an ability to play long sustained lines, dynamic contrast and phrasing. Your son's instrumental teacher should be able to advise you on repertoire which will fulfil these requirements. If your son is also auditioning on a second instrument, he should prepare one piece only on this second instrument. Aural tests, sight reading and a short interview may also occur.
