Form of proxy

Where an instrument of proxy does not direct the proxy to vote either for or against each or any of the resolutions to be proposed, the proxy, including the Chairman of the meeting (where the Chairman is deemed to be given the proxy in accordance with sub-paragraph (b) thereof) may vote in any way the proxy deems fit.
