## **GRAYTHWAITE - Our Heritage, Our Future**



**1832** Thomas Walker purchases 39 acres of land. This land includes the 13 acres that today, is Shore School.

**1833** 'Euroka Cottage' is built by Thomas Walker.

**1853** 'Euroka Cottage' is sold to Edwin Sayers who adds a two story west wing.

**1873** 'Euroka Villa' is sold to Thomas Dibbs.

**1875** 'Euroka Villa' is redeveloped, the original cottage is demolished and the two story west wing is retained.

**1882** Thomas Dibbs occupies 'Euroka Villa' and renames the estate 'Graythwaite'.

**1915** Thomas Dibbs offers 'Graythwaite' as a gift to the State for sick and wounded soldiers and sailors under the control of The Red Cross.

**1978** 'Graythwaite' is placed on the Register of the National Estate.

**1980** Management is transferred to the Home of Peace Hospitals for community geriatric use.

**2000** Limited maintenance programme, 'Graythwaite' is deteriorating rapidly.

**2002** 'Graythwaite' is listed on the State Heritage Register.


**2005** 'Graythwaite' nominated for inclusion on the National Heritage List.

**2008** Supreme Court decision to sell 'Graythwaite' – funds to be used for a new aged care facility.

**2009** 'Graythwaite' is purchased by Shore School.

**2013** 'Graythwaite' restoration commences.

2014 'Graythwaite' restoration complete.
